 The Board of Directors reviewed and discussed the current drought conditions and the RAWS Drought Contingency Plan. Current lake levels are at 30.1%.

# UPDATE FROM THE DISTRICT ON SYSTEM OPERATIONS

- Marcos Alaniz with The District provided the following updates to the Board of Directors:
  - a. Residuals have been holding well. CR 75 residuals are sitting at 0.80 and the remainder of the system is between 1.5 and 2.0. Flushing has been reduced.
  - b. Ron made a motion to accept the bid from Hierholzer Engineering, Inc for a wireless link from the RAWS office to The District to ensure connectivity for the SCADA system is maintained. However, there was no second for the motion, so it did not carry.

#### UPDATE FROM RAWS ENGINEER, PAUL PILARCZYK

- 8. Mr. Paul Pilarczyk, the Corporation's engineer provided the following updates to the Board of Directors:
  - a. The Project Information Form (PIF) for the Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) was submitted on May 23, 2023, for consideration of funds for the Lead and Copper Rule Revision. Preliminary results placed RAWS in a position of 55 out of a total of 257 systems. No new information is currently available.
  - RAWS was not selected for the Asset Management Program for Small Systems that was submitted on November
    2, 2023, to the Texas Water Development Board. This can be applied for each year.
  - c. No updates on the Quality Assurance (QA) Coatings Inspections for the EST by Dunham Engineering.
  - d. The repairs and maintenance on the existing EST by Stoic Industrial Coatings, LLC is on track to be completed by March 6, 2024.
  - e. No action taken on repairing customer driveway on 624 as a result of new water line installation.
  - f. Upon motion by Mike Olszewski and a second by Jeff Holley, the Board of Directors unanimously approved to have A&R Septic cap the drain lines impeding on RAWS property neighboring 5336 CR75 for a total of \$875.
  - g. No action taken on installing a new service line to the RAWS system from The District.
