RECEIVE UPDATE FROM THE DISTRICT ON CURRENT LAKE LEVELS AND DROUGHT CONDITIONS

- The Board of Directors reviewed and discussed the following:
 - a. A total of 6 water wells being drilled by City of Corpus Christi
 - b. Wells are being drilled approx. 800-900ft down
 - c. Wells will have approx. 1m-2m flow rate per well each day
 - d. Pending approval from TCEQ to put pumped water from wells into Nueces River
 - e. The District planning an interconnect with City of Corpus for additional water sources
 - f. Water rights will remain the same for The District and City of Corpus
 - g. Discussed alternate sources of water i.e. Mary Rhodes pipeline
 - h. Discussed drought conditions around the state such as:
 - i. Beeville
 - ii. San Antonio
 - iii. Edwards Aquifer
 - iv. Carrizo/Wilcox Auquifer
 - v. Canyon Lake
 - vi. Travis Lake
 - vii. Head waters of the Nueces River

DISCUSS AND TAKE ACTION ON WARRANTY INSPECTION FOR ELEVATED STORAGE TANK

7. The Board of Directors reviewed and discussed the warranty inspection report from Dunham Engineering for the elevated storage tank following one year of repairs done by Stoic Industrial Coatings, LLC. No action was taken.

The Board of Directors reviewed and discussed two quotes for repairs on the Elevated Storage Tank: one from Stoic Industrial Coatings totaling \$9k and the other from Texas Tank Services totaling \$14k. Upon motion by Jeff Holley and seconded by Ron Hellberg, the Board of Directors approved the Stoic Industrial Coatings quote, less \$2k for the Auxiliary pipe blind flange which has since been corrected following the inspection by Dunham Engineering. Director John Fernan abstained from voting.
